#### Opportunity: *Student Researchers*

The BHR Manual is hiring 4 (four) Student Researchers. The Student Researchers will select a topic from the following (more to be announced), to write an article of approximately 7,000 words on the selected topic:

1. Corporate Legal Accountability in the Extraction Industry
2. Human Rights and Anti-Corruption Protection in Sports
3. UN Guiding Principles & SDGs
4. Modern Slavery

Student Researchers will be assigned an academic or legal practitioner supervisor for research guidance and will be expected to fully comply with the editing process and standards of the BHR Manual.

- Excellent research and writing skills
- Keen attention to detail
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
